Duty-free Leather Products Shop Officially Opened at Bole International Airport

The Ministry of Industry, together with Ethiopian Airlines, has officially inaugurated a duty-free leather and leather products store at Bole International Airport.

The main purpose of opening the shop is to promote export of Ethiopian products and increase the trade of the sector. Ethiopian Airlines has allocated about 200 meters square area at Bole International Airport terminal for the duty free shop while Japan International Corporation (JICA) has been providing financial and technical support for the realization of the duty free shop. Ethiopian to start cargo flights to Dire Dawa, Jigjiga

The announcement comes after the government launched Ethiopia's first Free Trade Zone (FTZ) in the Dire Dawa city administration on Sunday, August 14, 2022.

Last month, Transport and Logistics Minister Dagmawit Moges, met with Ethiopian Airlines Group CEO Mesfin Tasew to discuss the role that the airlines can play to make the free trade zone's operation effective.

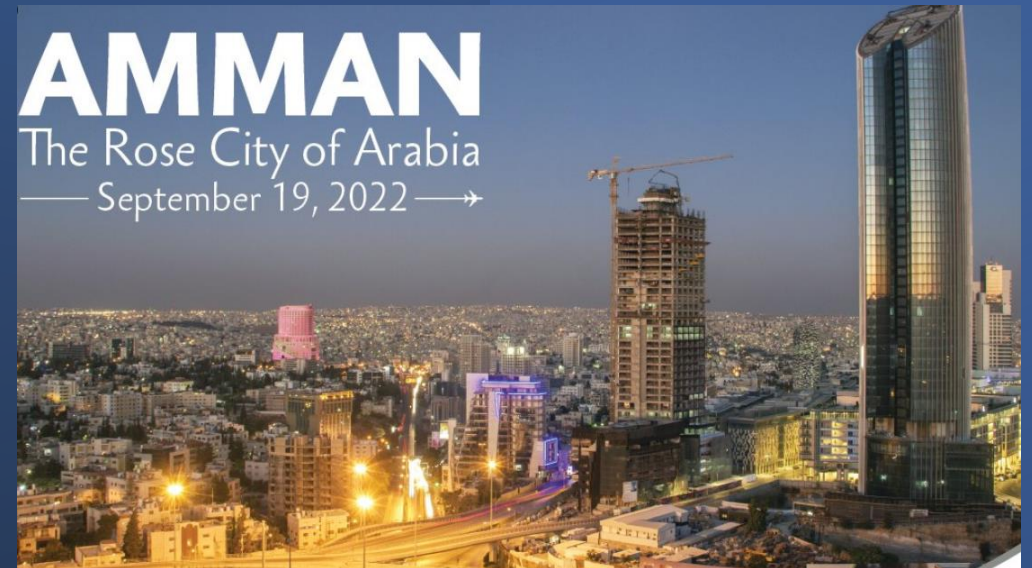

With the addition of Bulawayo, Ethiopian global destinations reach 131. The new flight will be operated with B787 on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays. Bulawayo, also known as “The City of Kings” is rich in cultural history and is the second largest city in Zimbabwe after the capital, Harare. Ethiopian Airlines Group CEO Mesfin Tasew, said “We are continually growing our network in Africa to provide affordable and convenient air connectivity and facilitate trade within Africa and beyond.
