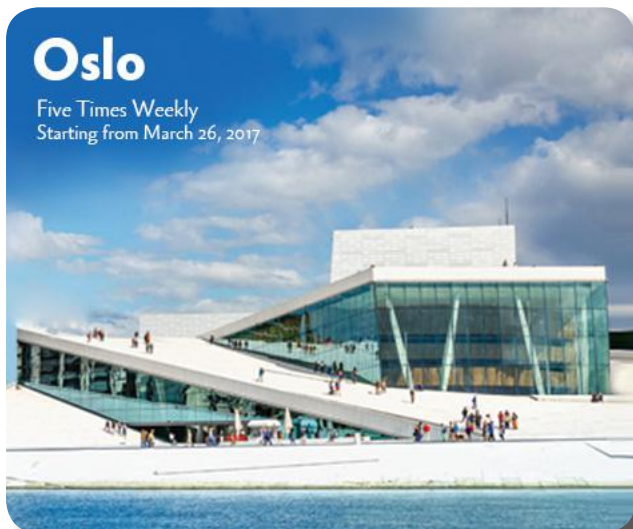

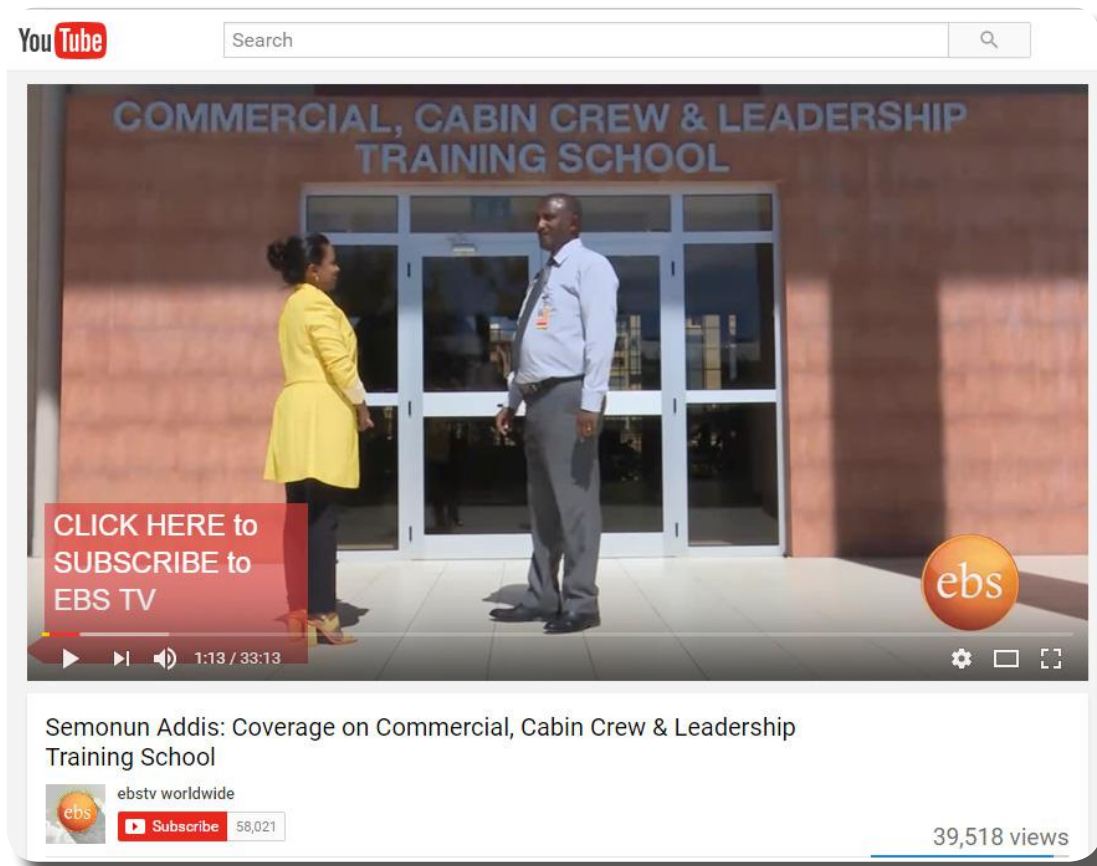

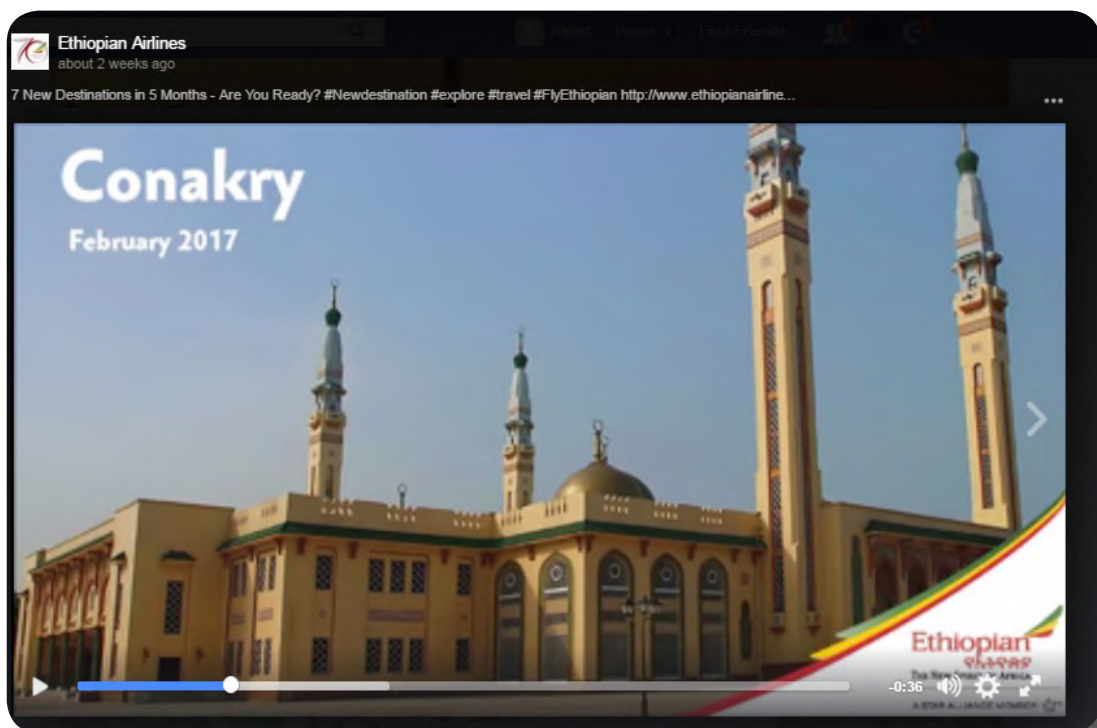

Cloud 9. That's the business class cabin of Ethiopian Airlines. The one in the A350. This is where you want to be when you leave the tarmac to head for Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. It's the first Airbus A350 to fly long-haul out of Heathrow. And the first to fly in African skies.



Let's start at the beginning. The airline shares a lounge with United at Heathrow. But if you're flying from Addis Ababa, they have their own own dedicated space – with bar, children's area, business centre and even an Ethiopian coffee corner.

The aircraft itself boasts spacious seats – which turn into 78" fully lie-flat beds – plus enough headroom for a stooping gentle giant, panoramic windows for watching the angels fly past, and low twin engine noise level... ahh. (Although I didn't notice the purring engines as much as the irritating ping-pinging noise in the galley behind; the sound of economy fliers pressing their call buttons).

Cargo terminal to go operational in April

The New Ethiopian Airlines Cargo Terminal, for which 82 percent of the construction has been completed, is expected to be operational in April 2017, a press release issued by Ethiopian said.

Up on completion, terminal will have an annual storage capacity of 1.2 million tons of both dry and perishable cargo and will have a capacity to handle eight B747-800 freighters at a time.

Upon going operational, the uplifting capability of the terminal will be equivalent to cargo terminals at Amsterdam Schiphol, Singapore Changi or Hong Kong, the airline said.

Construction of the first phase will cost approximately USD 150 million.

Recapping the Airline's performance in 2016, Group CEO Ethiopian Airlines, Tewolde Gebremariam, said Ethiopian was successful in the concluded year, despite the challenges posed in African aviation industry. Ethiopian Airlines announced on December 24, 2016 that it would be commencing new services to Jakarta, Indonesia, beginning in June 2017. The carrier will be sending its latest Boeing 787-800 to the destination on June 2, 2017. It has planned a three times a week flight to Indonesia's capital, with a stop at Bangkok. Ethiopian's CEO Tewolde Gebremariam said that the airline hopes the move will further connect Africa to Asia. Jakarta is the fourth most populous country in the world. 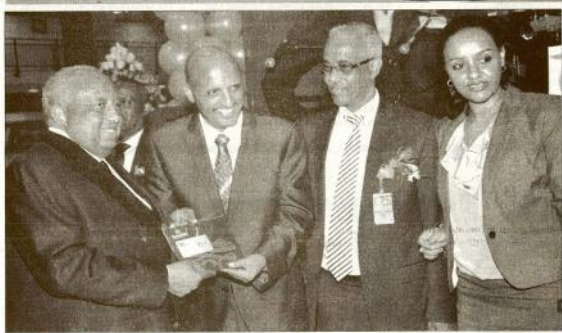

Ethiopian to open seven new destinations

ADDIS ABABA -- Ethiopian Airlines, Africa's largest airline group, announces that it will launch seven new destinations in five months time. This is one of the greatest expansions in Ethiopian's long and illustrious history.

In a press release, Ethiopian said it would launch new service to Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe), Antananarivo (Madagascar), Conakry (Guinea), Oslo (Norway), Chengdu (China), Jakarta (Indonesia) and Singapore (Singapore) starting from February to June. With the addition of these stations, Ethiopian would have service from Addis to 98 different international cities

across the world.

Ethiopian Airlines Group CEO, Tewolde Gebremariam said: "Africa's share of the Global Aviation is the smallest which is only around three percent. As the largest airline group in the continent, we are highly concerned on the low base of air connectivity in the continent."

"We are setting record expansion to enable Africans enjoy safe, reliable and economical air connectivity both within the continent and between the continent and the rest of the world," he added.

Tewolde also said: "Looking beyond the current economic slowdown especially in the oil export dependent economies of Africa, we

firmly believe that the continent will become the magnet for foreign direct investment, trade and tourism, which are the engines of air travel growth."

"In turn efficient air connectivity also drives socio-economic development and we are happy to contribute our share in the 21st Century African Transformation" the CEO added.

In 2016, new flights to Moroni (Comoros), Windhoek (Namibia) and New York (United States) were launched, as well as three cities in Ethiopia: Hawassa, Kebri Dahar and Dembidolo.

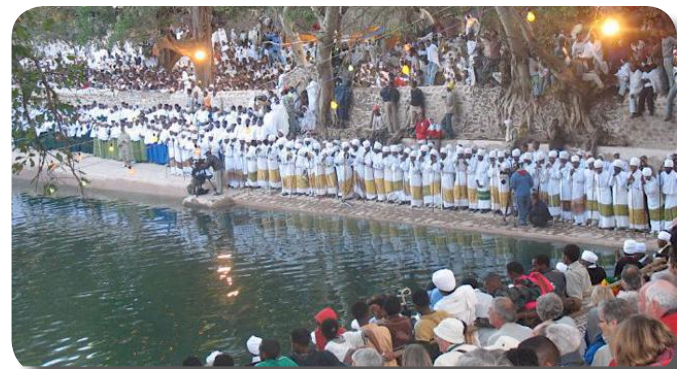
Timket - Ethiopian Epiphany- Baptism of Christ



Timket is the greatest festival of orthodox Christians in Ethiopia. Falling on the 19 of January (or the 20 of January once in every four years), it celebrates the baptism of Christ in the river Jordan by John the Baptist. It's a three-day affair and all the ceremonies are conducted with great pomp. The eve of Timket (18 January) is called Ketera. On this day the tabots of each church are carried out in procession to a place near a river where the next day's celebration will take place. A special tent is set up for each tabot, each hosting a proud manner depicting the church's saint. The ceremony is accompanied by hymns and dances of the priests, drum beating, bell ringing and blowing of trumpets.

It is the tabot rather than the church building, which is consecrated, and it is accorded extreme relevance. The priests pray throughout the night and mass is performed around 2 AM. Processional crosses of varying size and elaboration as well as various Ethiopian artifacts can be seen on the occasion. When the tabot is carried out, it is wrapped in brocade or velvet and carried on the head of a priest with colorful ceremonial umbrellas to shade it.

The next morning (19Jan) around dawn ecclesiastics and believers go to the water and attend the praying. A senior priest dips a golden processional cross in the water to bless it and extinguishes a consecrated candle in it. Then he sprinkles the water on the people in commemoration of Christ's baptism.



A tabot is a replica of the Arc of the Covenant and the ten tablets of the law which Moses received on Mount Sinai.



Many believers leap fully dressed into the water to renew their vows. Timket Krestos - baptism of Christ – is merely a commemoration, not an annual rebaptism. After the baptism the tabots of each church, except St. Michael's church, start their way back to their respective churches. The elders walk solemnly, accompanied by singing, leaping of priests and young men and beating of prayer sticks in an ancient ritual.

The next day (20 January) is the feast of the Archangel Michael, Ethiopia's most popular saint. This morning, his tabot is returned to his church, again accompanied by singing and dancing of priests. This marks the end of the three-day celebration. The best place to attend the event is Lalibela, Gondar or Addis Ababa. In Addis Ababa many tents are pitched at Jan Meda, in the northeast part of the city. Crowds with lit oil lamps attend the mass at 2 AM.
